



## Amelia "Amy" Sue Fitch

Amelia Sue "Amy" Fitch passed away May 9, 2016, at the age of 71. Amy was born to James B. Fitch and Geraldine Fitch in Erick, Oklahoma on June 2, 1944. She was raised on the West Coast, where her dad was stationed in the Navy. She and her family moved to Lindsay, Oklahoma, in 1961 when her dad retired from the service. She graduated from Lindsay High School in 1962. After graduation she moved to Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, working at various department stores, Lerner's and John A. Brown's, just to name a few.
