



Arthur Dolphus Nunn

August 7, 1922 - December 3, 2013

Arthur Dolphus "Art" Nunn, age 91, died December 3, 2013 at the Lindsay Manor Nursing Home. He was born August 7, 1922 at Vernon, Texas to Wilburn Arthur Nunn and Vela Kirkpatrick Nunn.

Art left his home at an early age and supported himself doing mostly farm work until he enlisted in the army shortly after his 18th birthday in 1940. He served in the 9th Infantry and was a true member of the "Greatest Generation". While serving in Northern France in Normandy, he was seriously wounded in battle and spent over two months in a military hospital. He received an EAME Campaign Medal with two Bronze Stars, a Silver Star and a Purple Heart. He was a Squad Leader and was a Staff Sgt. at the time he was discharged on August 1, 1945, still a week short of his 23rd birthday.

Mr. Nunn worked for many years for Cities Services, Pipeline Division, retiring from that company in 1981. He was a licensed electrician and plumber.

He married his wife, Marcia, on November 12, 1972, and after his retirement, they lived for many years in Red River, New Mexico. They moved to Lindsay, Oklahoma in 1996. He was an active member of the community, always ready to lend a helping hand. He was a member of the First Baptist Church and an active member of the American Legion.

He is survived by two children from his first marriage: Jeff Nunn and his wife, Julie, of Wichita, Ks, and Cindy Bravi and her husband, David, of Saratoga Springs, N.Y., six grandchildren, Jerod Rose and wife, Sylvia, Kendra Nunn, Kristy Bansemer and husband Brandon, Sandy Hoag, David Hoag, Tim Hoag, and Lisa Furman; five great-grandchildren, Alexis Rose, Joseph Bansemer, L. J. Bansemer, Ashley Furman and Kira Furman. He is also survived by two step-daughters, Sheneesta Heatly and husband, Charlie, of Lindsay, Oklahoma and Aquanetta Pitzer and husband, Gary, of Oklahoma City; three step-grandchildren, Danny Heatly and wife, Dana, of Norman, Ok., Tracy Heatly Leese of Ft.
