Austin W. Bellows, age 86, of Lindsay, Oklahoma departed his earthly life on Wednesday, June 16th, 2010 at Norman Regional Hospital in Norman, Oklahoma. Born March 10, 1924 in Kiefer, Oklahoma, Austin was the son of Earl D. and Ida Belle Bellows. He married Bennilee Winkle on November 6th, 1946 in Wellington, Kansas.
