Avery Daniel Robison was born on January 2, 1991 in Chickasha, Oklahoma to Allen D. "A.D." and DeAnn Robison, and he was the 1991 Grady County New Year's Baby. He was a lifetime resident of Lindsay, Oklahoma and graduated from Lindsay High School in 2009. He was employed by Webb Oil.
