B.L. "Short" Landers of Lindsay, Oklahoma passed from this life on Friday, April 27, 2012 at his home at the age of 94. He was born on February 21, 1918 in Lindsay, Oklahoma to Edgar Landers and Ova (Stephens) Landers.

Short joined the U.S. Army on January 10, 1942, and served as an automotive mechanic and a rifle marksman. He went to battle in the Southern Philippines. He attained the rank of Sergeant and received the Good Conduct Medal and the Philippine Liberation Ribbon with Star. Short was honorably discharged from the Army on January 23, 1946. Short was a farmer.

Mr. Landers is survived by his brother, Bill Landers and wife Ruth, two nieces, Lana Sue Johnson and husband Ken and Janice Stahl and husband John along with two great-nieces, one great nephew and one great-great-niece.
