Betty Jean Moore Jernigan was born on January 17, 1928 in Lindsay, Oklahoma to Marion Moore and Lottie (Glass) Moore. She married Donald Lee Jernigan on October 13th, 1945 in Winfield, Kansas. Betty passed from this life into the hands of her Heavenly Father on Saturday, May 21st, 2011 in Lindsay, Oklahoma at the age of 83.
