



## Bill Eubank

December 11, 1934 - April 1, 2013

Bill Eubank of Lindsay, Oklahoma departed this life on Monday, April 1, 2013 at Lindsay Municipal Hospital in Lindsay at the age of 78. Bill was born on December 11, 1934 in Pocahontas, Arkansas to Elmer and Alta Eubank. He married Helen Jo Guinn on December 4, 1959 in Poteau, Oklahoma.

Bill served his country in the 48th Army Medical Corps and was stationed at Waltham, Massachusetts, and was then sent to Baumholder, Germany. He moved to Lindsay, Oklahoma in 1974 to manage Lindsay's Department Store. He purchased the store in 1976, and it became Eubank's Department Store. In 1979, he purchased and remodeled the Waldron Theatre which became Eubank's Western Corner. Bill was a member of the American Legion and the Lindsay Chamber of Commerce, and he also helped organize girls softball in Lindsay. His happiest times were watching his grandkids play and play sports. Bill had a love for any kind of gun and for classic cars, and he enjoyed making deals on both.
