Bill Wiersema was born on January 22, 1942 in Cheyenne, Wyoming to Roy and Florence Wiersema. He served his country as a member of the U.S. Army from July of 1960 to July of 1966. He worked for the Federal Government in Civil Service and in Law Enforcement, retiring from Fort Sill in Lawton, Oklahoma after 40 years of Federal Service. Bill moved from Fletcher, Oklahoma to Lindsay, Oklahoma in November of 2005 and married Patricia Sue Hutcheson on November 5, 2005 at the First Assembly of God in Lindsay.
