Bobby Eugene Hearon was born February 9th, 1943 in Phoenix, Arizona. He was the youngest of 9 children born to Buford Chester “Boots” and Katie Mae (Dunn) Hearon.

Bobby was raised in the Bradley and Lindsay, Oklahoma area, attending Bradley School. In 1957, Bobby joined the Army National Guard, serving for two years. In 1959, Bobby re-enlisted in the United States Army, serving in Reiss, Germany near the Czechoslovakian border. Bobby served with “K” Troop 3rd Recon Squad, 11th Armored Cavalry. Bobby was honorably discharged in 1963 after proudly serving his country for six years.

In 1966, Bobby met and later married Jackie Gray. To this marriage, they added two children, Teresa Darlene in 1967 and Justin DeWayne in 1975. Bobby and Jackie enjoyed 17 years together.

In 1984, Bobby married Margie Lou (Evins) in Gainesville, Texas. Bobby and Lou enjoyed a loving marriage of 33 years, residing in Bradley. To this union, Bobby gained 6 step-sons and 1 step-daughter.

In 1984, Bobby dedicated his life, heart and soul to our Lord and Savior. Within a year, Bobby was called to be a Pastor. For 31 years, Bobby reached thousands of people through his sermons and songs he and Lou would

perform. They owned their own church building for almost 20 years, associated with the Full Gospel Organization. Bobby was a very caring, compassionate Pastor. A call anytime day or night would send him running to the aid of someone in need. Up until his last days, Bobby was still attending church, along with his guitar and amp.

Bobby enjoyed reading his Bible, singing, playing the guitar, fishing and watching his grandson Kristjan pitch at baseball games, play football and basketball.

Bobby departed this world early Sunday morning, April 16, 2017 at his home in Bradley, Oklahoma at the age of 74. He will be greatly missed by all who knew and loved him.
