



## Bobby Dean Hutto

March 10, 1935 - December 26, 2010

Bobby Dean Hutto, age 75, of Lindsay, OK passed away Sunday, December 26, 2010, in Lindsay, OK. Bob was born March 10, 1935 in Oklahoma City, OK to James Wiley Hutto and Della Brada Estes Hutto. Bob was raised in Lindsay, OK and attended Lindsay schools where he excelled in basketball, baseball and football. Bob attended Murray State College in Tishomingo, Oklahoma and East Central in Ada, Oklahoma where he played football.

After high school and college, he enjoyed a career in the Army and the United States Air Force where he lived in Alaska, France, Iran, Turkey, and the United States. He virtually saw the world as a career serviceman. After he retired and moved back to Lindsay, he loved to participate in the American Legion and to be part of the Honor Guard at funerals. He was vigilant in helping distribute and display flags on all National Holidays. He was a member of the First Baptist Church and AARP.

Bob loved people and loved to make people laugh. He loved to trick and tease people and his favorite hobby was to make signs for people and to collect and distribute jokes. He knew no strangers and befriended everyone he met, from former classmates, to waitresses, to salesmen, to grocery clerks. He never spoke ill of anyone past or present and only asked that you make him laugh. He loved to watch Lindsay basketball and football, and he delighted in watching any college football game that he could, especially University of

Oklahoma and Oklahoma State University.

He married his high school sweetheart, Carolyn Bayless Hutto, in 2005 after reconnecting with her at the 2002 Lindsay Class Reunion. Survivors include his wife, Carolyn Hutto of the home, his daughter, Suzanne Nerren and husband Mike Nerren of Benton, Louisiana; two step daughters, Alisa Bennett and husband Craig, Angela Cass and husband Chuck of Atlanta, Georgia. He leaves behind seven grandchildren, Chance, Laurel, and Coleman Nerren of Benton, Louisiana; Brett and Jack Bennett and Evan and Ryan Cass of Atlanta, Georgia. He also leaves several cousins including Wayne Estes and his wife Suzanne, H.O.
