Burnice Estelle (Benefield) Romans was born on May 2, 1906 in Minden, Louisiana. She was the eldest child of Clyde Benefield and Nannie (Linton) Benefield. She married Claud Major Romans in Duncan, Oklahoma in 1924. She departed this life on Wednesday, November 21, 2012 at her home in Lindsay, Oklahoma at 106 years of age.

Claud and Burnice moved to Lindsay with their children in 1938. They owned and operated a bakery on Main Street for many years, delivering bread and other baked goods to several towns in the area. Mrs. Romans herself drove the bread truck for sixteen years. She was a dedicated member of the Lindsay United Methodist Church. She was also a member of the UMW, AARP and RSVP. She loved flower gardening, cooking and baking, crocheting afghans and doing for others. She was always busy.

"Romans" is survived by her grandchildren: Candice Stockstill Freeman and Donald Wayne Romans, Jr., one great-granddaughter, Christy Louise Cravey and one great-great grandson, Gregory Benjamin Maupin Cravey.

Mrs. Romans was preceded in death by her parents, Clyde and Nannie Benefield, one daughter, Dorthy Louise Stockstill who passed in 2005, one son, Donald Wayne Romans who passed in 1959, two younger brothers and two younger sisters.
