



## Causine Willis McCoy

October 19, 1934 - June 8, 2019

Causine Willis McCoy was born at home on October 19, 1934 in Bradley, Oklahoma as the oldest son of Loyd Arnold and Jessie Irene (Bryant) McCoy. He passed from this life on Saturday, June 8, 2019 at the Lexington Nursing Home in Lexington, Oklahoma, at the age of 84 years, 7 months, and 20 days.

He grew up in the Lindsay area and attended school at New Hope, See Chapel, Bradley, Lindsay, and Hughes. He was a hard worker and began driving a tractor in the fields at the age of nine and drove a commercial hay truck at the age of seventeen. Professionally he drove for Hoenig Transportation and Tulsa Crude Oil. He began driving cross country for Transcon Lines and finished his cross country driving with Northwest Freight Lines and P.I.E. He was a retired teamster with twenty-five years of accident-free driving and a member of the Three Million Mile Club in Dallas, Texas. After his retirement he drove trucks locally for Scott Standridge and Don English.

Causine enjoyed visiting with people and telling his funny little riddles and stories. He also enjoyed family dinners, taking care of his horses and mules, going on wagon trail rides, and piddling on his old John Deere tractors at the farm.

Causine was united in marriage with Leota Alcorn on October 4, 1955. They

were married 63 years, 6 months, and 4 days. To this union was born four sons and one daughter.

Causine was saved and baptized in 1967, at the First Baptist Church in Cherokee, Oklahoma, and at the time of his death he was a member of the First Baptist Church in Lindsay, Oklahoma.

He is survived by his wife Leota (Alcorn) McCoy of the home, sons Gloyd McCoy of Noble, Lloyd McCoy and wife Marci of Lindsay, Gary McCoy and wife Rachelle of Mustang, Monte McCoy of Oklahoma City, and daughter Brandi (McCoy) Williams and husband Billy of Lindsay, his grandsons; Lloyd McCoy Jr. and Cody McCoy, his granddaughters; Erin and Jacob, Brianna and Hagen, Gabrielle, McKenna, Jazmine, Mallory, and Brinlee, his brother; Cecil McCoy and wife Jane of Moore, his sisters Evangeline Nesmith of Clear Point, Alabama and Patty Harras and Hermann Lehmann of Napa, California, and several nieces and nephews.
