Cecil D. "Tractor Man" Smith of Lindsay, Oklahoma passed from this life on Wednesday, December 21, 2011 at the V.A. Medical Center in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma at the age of 86. Cecil was born in Ponca City, Oklahoma on November 15, 1925 to J.D. "Jim" Smith and Ollie E. (Duncan) Smith. He married Freida Marie Johnson on September 16th, 1950 in Purcell, Oklahoma.
