



## Cecil E. Williams

September 16, 1917 - September 22, 2013

Cecil E. Williams, 96, died Sunday, September 22, 2013 in Connerville, IN. He was born in Altus, OK, on September 16, 1917 and was one of 10 children. He enlisted in the Army on August 26, 1940 and served as a Mess Sergeant aboard convoy ships in the Pacific Theater during World War II. He relocated to Lindsay after the war and began working for the Rural Electric Cooperative where he retired in 1977 after 32 years of employment. He was a member of the First Baptist Church and served as a Sunday School Teacher, Usher and Deacon. His lifelong passion was fishing, and he rarely missed a day in pursuit of his hobby.

He was preceded in death by his first wife of 36 years, Wynona Hunter Williams and his second wife of 31 years, Emogene Reynolds Williams, both of Lindsay, OK.
