February 4, 1938 - March 4, 2014

Charles (Charlie) Ronald Jones, of Lindsay, died Tuesday, March 4, 2014 surrounded by his loving family.

Charlie was born on February 4, 1938 in Comanche, OK to Emma and Herman Jones. He grew up in a large family with three sisters and five brothers. As a boy, he loved to play baseball, basketball and hunt with his brothers and close friends. He told stories of all day baseball games in his backyard and laying out under the cottonwood trees in autumn "plugging" squirrels for supper.

Charlie met Barbara Hill at Comanche High School and they became an "item" in 1955. They were married February 15th, 1958 at the First Baptist Church of Comanche. They moved to Lindsay, OK in 1959 and soon became parents of three beautiful girls, often referred to as "Charlie's Angels".

Anyone who knew Charlie knew after his Lord and family, music was his third love but running neck in neck with the other two. Charlie and his brothers, The In Crowd, played a wide variety of music from his own compositions to gospel and rock and roll. He loved Elvis, Engelbert Humperdinck and Johnny Mathis and they were very influential in his style.

His love of music and people naturally led to radio sales for KWCO/KXXX in

Chickasha, OK. Although very successful, this just wasn't enough for Charlie. In 1988 he opened the first video rental store followed shortly by his own KBLP radio station in 1991, both in Lindsay. For Charlie, KBLP was much more than a job or business but a way to give to a community he dearly loved. His station was Lindsay first and everything else after. Not only was he the voice of Lindsay sports but he hosted his annual radio show, "Turkey Talk", contributing hundreds of turkeys and hams to those in need. Charlie personally adopted families or individuals in need, spending thousands of dollars to ensure they had warm clothes, bicycles and toys.

For many years, Charlie helped out his good friend, Charles K. Heatly with providing musical entertainment on Sunday nights and Tuesday nights for the famous Lindsay Girls Basketball Camp. There are countless people who know Charlie from those days and can still hear the music in their ears.

Some of the best times enjoyed by Charlie and his family were the "family vacations". The vacations weren't always elaborate or long in traveling time but always included an ice chest with cokes and sandwich fixins. Usually by the time the family was somewhere between Lindsay and Wallville Road, the cry from the back seat would ring out, "I'm hungry" and/or "I'm thirsty". So without hesitation, Charlie would pull to the side of the road and break out the sandwich stuff to take care of the weary travelers, aka, the Jones' girls. Charlie would always go the extra mile to make sure everyone was catered to and got to experience everything they set out to do on their family trips. This was a tradition that continued on into the adult lives of his children and their families as well. The most recent trip was a trip to Branson, MO to see Johnny Mathis. The same rules applied. We are going to have fun, we will all participate no matter what and if you want to stop or need to stop, we stop.

Another tradition was the invention of the Charlie burger. On Sunday afternoons, Charlie would break out the grill and cook up the most

mouthwatering burgers perhaps that were ever made. This was much to the liking of the "gentlemen callers" that would somehow manage to show up on Sunday evenings to visit with one of his girls. This tradition lasted through the years and got adopted into the radio station remotes and eventually evolved into the Sunday dinner with the family.

Now there is one group of folks that belonged to a special society known only as the "Last Chance Club". This band of goof balls included a couple of his daughters and eventually all three of his girls and their associated guys and group of friends. Charlie and Barbara would open their home to that entire bunch for countle
