Charles Roy Powers of Lindsay, Oklahoma departed this life on Wednesday, March 24th, 2010 at the Norman Veterans Center in Norman, Oklahoma at the age of 80. Charles was born on December 21st, 1929 in Wanette, Oklahoma to Willie Archibald Powers and Winnie Gertrude (Newton) Powers.
