Clara Sullivan, age 92, formerly of Lindsay, OK, passed away in Houston, TX on November 9, 2000. She was born in Kellyville, OK on January 7, 1908 to Alonzo Robbins and Nancy Fields Robbins. They moved to Lindsay when Clara was a small girl. She lived in the Lindsay area almost 90 years, her grandfather having owned a hotel in early Lindsay and her father farmed north of town. She was a homemaker until her husband's death; she received a certificate for Home Health Care when in her seventies and worked several years in Lindsay assisting elderly people in their homes.
