Cletus W. Lang passed away on June 16, 2006. He was born on March 14, 1930, in Iowa Park, Texas to Claudie Robert and Willie Lee Lucille Lang. Cletus married Mary Kay Thomas on April 9, 1949, and has lived in the Lindsay area for the passed 32 years. After spending 24 years in the U. S. Air Force Cletus retired with the rank of Chief Master Sgt. During the time he served his country he flew medical evacuation and received a Bronze Star and Notorious Medal.

After Cletus retired from the Air Force he was a hospital administrator and sold mobile homes. He was affiliated with the Assembly of God Church in Lindsay, Oklahoma. Cletus was the president of the Rotary Club two times. He enjoyed watching his grandchildren play sports. He found great pleasure in listening to his grandchildren sing and being there for them with anything they were involved in.

Cletus is preceded in death by his parents, one son, William David "Bill" Lang, one brother, Claudie Lang and one sister, Nelda Benefield.

He is survived by his loving wife of 57 years, Mary Kay Lang, and one daughter, Derindia Kay Barrett of Purcell, Oklahoma, one brother, Wendell Lang of Paoli, Oklahoma, and one sister Linda Pope of Hartshorne, Oklahoma. Cletus also leaves behind four grandchildren; Elizabeth Kathryn

Barrett, J. Brock Barrett, Aury Lang Barrett, Seth Daniel Barrett, all of Purcell, Oklahoma and one great grandchild, Brayden "Cache" Barrett of Purcell, Oklahoma.

Services for Mr. Lang will be held at the Assembly of God Church in Lindsay, Oklahoma on June 20, 2006, at 2:00 p.m. Interment will be at the Eastman Cemetery in Marietta, Oklahoma.

In honor of Cletus' military service the Shepard Air Force Base Honor Guard will conduct a 21 gun salute, play "Taps" and present Mrs. Lang with the United States Flag.
