May 9, 1921 - April 16, 2014

Delno Finch Scruggs was born May 9, 1921 to Henry Clyde and Ethel Electra (Harris) Scruggs in Joy, OK. He left us on April 16, 2014, at Purcell, OK surrounded by his loving family.

As a small boy, the family moved to the Cox City area where Delno and his brothers attended school at Pike's Peak. In 1942, he was drafted into the U.S. Army where he served his country in World War II as a medic. He returned home to Oklahoma in 1946 and found the love of his life. He married Tina Lou Dutton on April 26, 1947 and to this union six children were born. Delno and Tina Lou lived and raised their family in the Lindsay area for almost 67 years.

Delno farmed in the early years of their marriage, in 1954 he became a fireman, a job he loved. He retired from the fire department in 1983. At the time of his death, he was Lindsay's oldest living retired fireman. After retirement, he worked various jobs to stay busy and active. He loved gardening and raising his fainting goats.

He loved his family. His grandchildren could bring a smile to his face, even when he was sick, and he called every one of them "George". When one of the grandkids walked in, he would smile at them and say "Hi, George". He will be greatly missed by all those that loved him so much.

Delno is survived by his wife, Tina Lou, of the home, one son, Kenneth Scruggs and wife Linda, four daughters, Joy Stewart, Della Thomas and husband, Mike, Becky White and husband, Carlton, and Twana Shoemake and husband, Glen, all of Lindsay, Oklahoma, 15 grandchildren, 34 great grandchildren, three great-great grandchildren, five sisters-in-law, and dear friends that he considered family, Sandra, Dru and Kristian Burns. He is also survived by a host of nieces, nephews, and other family members as well as a host of friends.
