February 25, 1932 - June 16, 2015

Dorothy Dodd was born February 25, 1932 to Ralph Alexander "R.A." Green and Mamie Lou Green in Olton, Texas, where she attended school and graduated from Olton High School. She married Jackson Dodd in Olton, Texas on January 29, 1950 and shortly thereafter started her family as a housewife on the family farm. After a move to Tishomingo, Oklahoma in 1960 where her family continued to grow, they moved to Lindsay with their 4 children in 1966. That year, Dorothy began working as the administrative secretary to the superintendent of Lindsay Schools where she remained for 38 years and retired in 2004 (A school tenure record). All 4 of her children attended and graduated from Lindsay High School. Dorothy's beloved husband, Jackson, passed away on March 16, 1996.

Dorothy was a member of the Lindsay United Methodist Church, Eastern Star, Rainbow Girls Worthy Advisor and a Blue Star Mom. She was an avid OU football fan and relished any and all news pertaining to it. She could be found every Fall Saturday afternoon in front of the television rooting passionately for her beloved Sooners! She also loved keeping up with the OKC Thunder basketball, reading, working crossword puzzles, as well as listening to music, playing the piano and singing. But her greatest interest and passion were all things pertaining to her children and grandchildren. She loved her family very much as they were the center of her universe. Her entire life was centered around her children's welfare, health and well-being. She also considered the

children who attended Lindsay Schools one of her own, and loved keeping up with the details of their lives. Dorothy departed this life on Tuesday, June 16, 2015 at Norman Regional Hospital in Norman, Oklahoma at the age of 83 with her family by her side. She will be greatly missed by her community, her friends and her loving family.

Dorothy is survived by her son, Steve Dodd and wife Donna of Bedford, Texas. Daughter, Sheralyn King and husband Mike of Dodge City, Kansas. Son, Roger Dodd of Lindsay, Oklahoma and son, Jeff Dodd and wife Penny of Highland Village, Texas. She is also survived by two sisters: Chollis George of Tucumcari, New Mexico and Frances Keibler of Columbia Falls, Montana.
