Dorothy C. Walker was born on May 29, 1919 in Foster, Oklahoma to Jim Henry and Myrtle Ella Walker. She graduated high school in Elmore City, Oklahoma and went on to graduate from East Central University in Ada, Oklahoma with a Bachelor's degree. She continued her education at Oklahoma University where she earned a Master's degree.

Dorothy was an elementary school teacher. She taught for three years in Antioch, Oklahoma and for three years in Maysville, Oklahoma. She then had a long teaching career at Lindsay Elementary School in Lindsay, Oklahoma shaping the lives of many children during her thirty-one years there. Dorothy was a member of the Church of Christ in Lindsay, Oklahoma and a member of the Retired Teachers Association. She loved traveling, shopping and bowling. She thrived outdoors and loved to be working and spending time in her flower or vegetable gardens. Dorothy departed this life on August 2, 2015 at her home in Lindsay at the age of 96.
