December 18, 1928 - April 1, 2010

Emery Wayne Scheer of Ada, Oklahoma and formerly a long-time resident of Lindsay, Oklahoma died April 1, 2010 at his home in the Baptist Village of Ada at the age of 81. He served in the United States Marine Corps in Korea, graduated from Central State College in Edmond, OK, and worked for Sun Pipeline Co. in Lindsay for more than 30 years before retiring. After retirement he taught stained glass classes at Mid-America Vo-Tech at Wayne, and was active in many local church and community activities in and around the Lindsay area.

Survivors include sons Gary Allen (Gayla), Arlington, TX, Barry Thomas (Janet), Corpus Christi, TX, Tracy Hoyle (Carolyn), Ada, OK, and Todd Lynn (Terri), Newalla, OK.
