Emmett Eugene “Gene” Huckby was born on July 29, 1929 to Emmett Leon Huckby and Elpha E. (Pritchett) Huckby in Norman, Oklahoma. He passed from this life at the age of 88 in Norman, Oklahoma.

Emmett lived in Lindsay most of his life, but moved around working in the oilfield. He was a member of the First Baptist Church in Lindsay, Oklahoma. He was also a member of the American Legion and Veterans of Foreign Wars organizations.

Emmett enlisted in the United States Navy in 1948 to serve his Country during the Korean War and was stationed at Fort Barrow in Alaska.

Emmett met and married Elizabeth Ann (House) Huckby in June of 1949. He later met and married Mary Lou (Roberts) Huckby in March of 2003.

Emmett loved his pet dogs and he loved to work. He was a very good mechanic. He owned a service station in Lindsay from 1959-1969. He then began working at Gerhart Industries as a sales engineer and continued that until his retirement.
