Euell Roberson was born on December 4, 1910 to Stephen and Elizabeth Roberson in Maries County, Missouri. He passed from this life on February 9, 2004 in Lindsay, Oklahoma, surrounded by his family. Euell had four brothers and five sisters. He married Lucille Jones on May 4, 1936 in Dixon, Missouri. They had two daughters, Wanda Harrell and Wilma Denson.
