Fannie Lou Stephens of Lindsay, Oklahoma entered into her eternal rest on Wednesday, September 1st, 2010 at Integrus Hospice in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma at the age of 78. Fannie was born on September 12th, 1931 in Wallville, Oklahoma to Albert Sydney Jackson Worley and Blanche Gladys Worley.

Fannie was raised in the Wallville and Hughes area, and she attended Hughes School. She moved to Lindsay at the age of twelve and graduated from Lindsay High School in 1950. Fannie married W. M.
