Francis W. Parker passed away on May 24, 2005 at the age of 98. He was born on March 22, 1907 to Benjamin Franklin and Matildi Lee (Bratcher) Parker in Brock, Texas. Francis married Dora Vada Norton on October 3, 1925 in Ada, Oklahoma. Three children were born from this marriage. After Dora Vada passed away in 1955, Francis married Rosie Carrie Denson.

Francis was a farmer until 1941. From 1941 until 1947 Francis owned a Hatchery and Farmer's Produce business. During the years of 1947 through 1956 he owned and operated the first automatic laundry in Lindsay.
