Fred J. Selzer, age 86, of Bradley, OK passed away in Lindsay on January 17, 2002. He was born in Bradley on July 18, 1915 to Edward Selzer and Freda (Zwahr) Selzer. Fred farmed and ranched in one place for 66 years. He belonged to the Oklahoma Cattlemens Association and was Boy Scout Leader of Alex # 56 Troop. He was also a member of the Methodist Church. Fred enjoyed hunting and fishing, but his first love was tending his cattle and tilling the soil.

On Sept. 27, 1935 he was married to Oletha V. Jones in Grady County. She preceded him in death on Dec. 3, 1985. He is also preceded in death by both parents. Edward died on Nov. 6, 1949 and Freda passed away on Sept. 29, 1970. Deceased brothers and sisters were, Edward in 1962; Nora in 1983; Bertha in 1998; Grace in 1912; Ella, 1990; Earnest (Boots), 1975; Frank who was a twin to Fred in 1919; and Arthur, 1983.
