February 6, 1919 - November 1, 2005

Geneva Bradley of Lindsay, Oklahoma, passed away November 1, 2005 at the age of 86. She was born on February 6, 1919 in Lindsay to Daniel R. and Ina Mae Street. She lived in Lindsay most of her life except for ten years when she lived in Clovis, New Mexico and three years in San Diego, California during World War II. Geneva married Burse Winter Bradley in February 1937 and was married until his passing in May of 1996. They were blessed with two children, Frances Jayne Hospodarsky and Bill Bradley. Geneva was a member of the First Christian Church, The Christian Women's Fellowship. She enjoyed china painting, crocheting, working with ceramics, reading and watching "her" Atlanta Braves baseball team. Geneva was a secretary at Pool Hospital; she was a bankteller at both banks in Lindsay, she also worked as a bankteller in Clovis New Mexico until opening her own floral shop there. She was the first supervisor for the Lindsay Senior Citizen Center until her retirement.

She is preceded in death by her parents, and her husband, Bruse.
