



## Grady Bunch

January 3, 1922 - October 14, 2014

Grady Bunch was born on January 3, 1922 in Lindsay, Oklahoma to Elihu "Buck" Bunch and Ora Lee (Largent) Bunch. He graduated from Hughes High School. He served his country during World War II (from 1942 to 1945) as a member of the U. S. Navy Seabees. Grady married Imogene "Jean" Yarbrough in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma on August 11, 1945. He was a 92 year resident of Lindsay, and worked in the oilfield for thirty years as a roustabout and a gang pusher. He retired from Cities Service Oil Company in 1983. Grady enjoyed farming and driving his John Deere Tractors. He was well known in the community, and he loved to talk to people. He was a member of the First Baptist Church where he served as a door greeter. He was also a member of the 56th Seabees. Grady passed from this life on Tuesday, October 14, 2014 at his home in Lindsay. His presence will be greatly missed in his community and by all those who knew and loved him.
