Harry Kent Moore Jr., age 90, of Lindsay, Oklahoma died Tuesday, January 31, 2006, following an extended illness. Harry was born September 20, 1915 in Lindsay. He was born the son of Harry and Anna Moore of Lindsay.

Harry grew up in Lindsay and graduated from high school in Lindsay. After high school he went to the Oklahoma A & M and was in the Kappa Sigma Fraternity.
