Herman Lindell Chambers of Lindsay, Oklahoma departed this life at Lindsay Manor Nursing Home in Lindsay, Oklahoma on November 24th, 2008 at the age of 83. He was born in Garvin County, Oklahoma on October 11, 1925 to Benjamin Francis Chambers and Anna May "Shipman" Chambers. He married Ramona Banks in Gainesville, Texas on October 1st, 1949.

As a young man, Herman proudly served his country in the United States Army from October 23, 1945 to February 1, 1947. Mr. Chambers was a man who enjoyed hunting, fishing, and gardening. He also loved fixing anything. Having been born and raised in the Lindsay area, he worked as a mechanic for Bud Freeman Chevrolet until 1964. He then moved to California and worked as a mechanic for Courtesy Chevrolet until his retirement in 1980. In 1983, he returned to Lindsay where he spent the remainder of his days.

Herman is survived by his daughter Pat Allen and husband Tom, his son, Lindell Chambers and wife Robyn and his son Terry Chambers. Mr. Chambers also leaves behind eleven grandchildren, six great-grandchildren and one great-great-grandchild.

Mr. Chambers was preceded in death by his wife of 53 years, Ramona Chambers, who passed on August 4th, 2003, his parents Ben and May Chambers, one sister, Opal Bishop and two brothers; Bud Chambers and
