



Hoben John Rogers

August 14, 1918 - October 16, 2013

Hoben John Rogers of Lindsay, Oklahoma, died October 16, 2013, at age 95.

Hoben was born August 14, 1918, in Beebe, Arkansas, the third of five children of Alvah Garfield and Gertrude Hoben Rogers. He was an honor graduate of Beebe High School, Class of 1935, and, also, of Beebe Junior College, Class of 1937. He married Nancy Lee Rogers, daughter of Logan Herbert Rogers and Wanda Parker Rogers, of Fort Smith, Arkansas, on August 8, 1943.

They moved to Lindsay, Oklahoma, in 1957 from Little Rock, Arkansas where for 17 years he had been associated with Bush-Caldwell Wholesale Hardware and Sporting Goods Company, and had achieved the position of Sales Manager.

He and his wife owned and operated the OTASCO Home and Auto Supply Store in Lindsay for 18 years, until their retirement in 1975. In 1964, they were honored as "Dealer of the Year" of OTASCO's many associate stores.

He had a deep interest in Lindsay's civic and community affairs. He was a member of Lindsay's Rotary Club for 26 years, serving on many committees and as President. He was one of the original group of citizens who initiated the planning and development of the Lindsay Municipal Hospital. A Charter

Member of Lindsay's Municipal Hospital Board, he served 14 years including two terms as Chairman. He was a Charter Member of the Lindsay Industrial Development Foundation, and was for many years an active member of the Lindsay Chamber of Commerce. He was a member of the committee that originated plans for the Lindsay Municipal Park and Golf Course. He worked at various assignments on the Lindsay United Fund, and served two terms as Drive Chairman.

He served 18 years on the Board of Directors of the American Exchange Bank of Lindsay. He was a 32nd degree Mason and a Shriner for most of his adult life, having received recognition as a 50-year member of each.

A 56-year member of Lindsay's United Methodist Church, he served many years on its Administrative Board, including one term as Chairman. He also served at various times as Sunday School Superintendent, Sunday School Teacher, and on numerous other committees.

He was a combat veteran of World War II, having served almost 2 years overseas in the European Theater of Operations. He entered the Army as a Private and attained the rank of Captain, Field Artillery. During his Army career, he was awarded a Battlefield Promotion to 1st Lieutenant, the Bronze Star Medal, 5 Bronze Battle Stars, and a Silver Battle Star.

He fought as a Forward Observer for the 561st Field Artillery Battalion in 5 major campaigns ? The Invasion of Normandy, The Liberation of Northern France, The Battle of the Bulge, The Battle for the Rhineland, and The Conquest of Central Europe.

He is survived by his wife, Nancy, of the home; a daughter, Linda R. Everitt, a City Attorney in Arlington, Texas; and a son, H. John Rogers, Jr., a Petroleum Engineer recently retired from Samson Resources Company in Tulsa,

Oklahoma; four grandchildren, Jennifer Holt, Meredith Lann, Bryan Rogers and Brandon Rogers; and four great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents; one brother, A.G. Rogers, Jr.; and three sisters, Mrs. Kathleen Knox, Mrs. Elaine Horton, and Mrs. Martha Bradberry.

Services will be October 21, 2013 at two o'clock p.m. at United Methodist Church, 114 W. Chickasaw, Lindsay, Oklahoma. Interment will follow at Green Hill Cemetery, Lindsay, Oklahoma. Services are under the direction of B. G. Boydston Funeral Home of Lindsay, Oklahoma. The family of Hoben Rogers requests that memorial contributions be made to: The Gold Star Museum, Camp Dodge, 7105 NW 70th Ave., Johnston, IA 50313-1824.
