February 22, 1925 - December 25, 2012

Howard Leon Ardrey departed this life on the evening of December 25, 2012, at his home in Lindsay, Oklahoma at the age of 87. Leon was born on February 22, 1925 in Hope, Oklahoma to Lillie Elizabeth Rebecca (Campbell) Ardrey and Lee On Ardrey. He married Bonnie Wainscott on September 27, 1945 in Wichita Falls, Texas.
