Hudson Lee White of Lindsay, Oklahoma passed from this life in Lindsay, Oklahoma on December 17, 2008 at the age of 60. Hudson was born on May 31, 1948 in Kansas City, Missouri to Eunice Chastine White and Florence Elizabeth (Alvis) White. He married Rebecca Ann Isgrig on July 9, 1966 in Kansas City, Missouri.
