January 1, 1946 - February 7, 2016

Hugh "Wayne" Gossett was born on New Year's Day, January 1, 1946 in Edmond, Oklahoma, to Opal Juanita Gossett and Carl Randolph Gossett. His family moved to Anadarko, Oklahoma, where he worked and played on the family farm and surrounding countryside making fun and interesting memories which he would recount over the years. He graduated from Anadarko High School in 1964 where he excelled as a player on the Anadarko Warriors football team. Many of his fondest memories were of his days in high school where he made life-long friends. He would always get excited when it was time for another class reunion.

Wayne married June Louise Tenny on October 16, 1965. They had a daughter, Tracy Lynn in 1967. She was Wayne's "Baby Girl" and he was her rock. They had a special bond that carried them through good and bad times. Tracy's good friend Crisa Dausch became like a second daughter to Wayne, and Crisa saw him as a father figure all of her life. June passed away on November 11, 1986.

When living in Lindsay, Oklahoma, he met and then married Lila Kay Lindsey on September 10, 1988 at the First Baptist Church in Lindsay. He was the love she had been waiting for. He and Lila had a son, Tucker Dakota in 1997. Wayne, having already raised a daughter, Tracy, now had a son and new hope of having a lineman on the football team. He delighted in Tucker's every

accomplishment, but mostly just loved and enjoyed being with his best buddy. Tucker's own achievements on the Lindsay leopard football team were some of Wayne's proudest moments. However, Wayne being not only a husband and father, but also a grandfather and great-grandfather loved and cherished his family. He had a strong relationship with his two brothers, Troy and Carl and his little sister, Nita. The four of them all liked to keep one another laughing; but Wayne was like that with most everyone. He just loved to give people moments of laughter. He also had a tender heart and was not ashamed to shed a frequent tear or to tell loved ones how much, they meant to him. He loved animals, mostly dogs, and his dogs became truly family members. His little dog, Rascal, kept him company after he retired and made him continuously laugh.

Wayne worked in many positions throughout his life, but he retired from Hydra-Walk Key Energy in 2010. He enjoyed golfing, vacations and outings with his family, watching Tucker play football and watching football on TV, especially the Dallas Cowboys and the OU Sooners.

Wayne departed to his Heavenly home on Sunday, February 7, 2016 surrounded by family and friends at Norman Regional Hospital in Norman, Oklahoma, at the age of 70 years.
