J. D. Bryant of Lindsay, Oklahoma went home to be with his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ on Saturday, September 7, 2013 at Lindsay Manor Nursing Home in Lindsay, Oklahoma at the age of 93. J. D. was born on December 3, 1919 to BertieLee Bryant and Essie Mary (Campbell) Bryant. He married Wilma Earline Coody on May 5, 1946 in Wichita, Kansas.

J. D. lived in Garvin County, Oklahoma for most of his life and had lived in Lindsay since 1946. He served his country in Europe during World War II as a member of the U. S. Army. He was a member of the Church of Christ and served as a minister at churches in Lindsay, Foster, Verden and Blanchard. J. D. was a fisherman who truly loved to fish. He worked as a contract oilfield pumper, but first and foremost, he ministered to others. He leaves a legacy of showing Christ's love to everyone he met. He will be greatly missed.

Mr. Bryant is survived by his wife, Wilma Bryant, three sons: Joe Bryant and wife Dyanne, Fred Bryant and wife Margaret and Charles Bryant and wife Vicki, two brothers, Virgil Bryant of Duncan, Oklahoma and Floyd "Pete" Bryant of Fresno, California.
