Jack Morris of Lindsay, Oklahoma departed this life on Saturday, November 6th, 2010 at Pauls Valley General Hospital in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma at the age of 83. Jack was born in Stephens County, Oklahoma on March 25th, 1927 to Aud Allen Morris and Cassie Claire (Walker) Morris.

Jack lived all of his life near Purdy, Oklahoma, having lived on his farm for fifty-seven years. He served his country in the U.S. Army during World War II from 1945 to 1948, serving in Germany.
