September 13, 1910 - August 16, 2004

Jack Newton Nye of Bradley, Oklahoma passed away on August 16, 2004 at the age of 93. Jack was born September 13, 1910 to Arthur Wilson Nye and Etta Sofa Nye in Sulphur, Oklahoma.

Jack and Forrest Tollison were married in Alex, Oklahoma on April 27, 1935 by Justice of the Peace, Judge Chambers. Jack and Forrest made their home in Bradley, Oklahoma and lived and raised their family there. He was a member of the First Baptist Church in Bradley, Oklahoma. Jack was also the sexton of the Bradley Cemetery for many years.

Jack enjoyed fishing and gardening and just doing hard manual work. He farmed in his early years and worked at the Bradley School as a janitor and school bus driver until his retirement in 1980.
