James Michael "Jimmy" Johnson of Chickasha, Oklahoma departed this life on Tuesday, March 30th, 2010 at St. Anthony Hospital in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma at the age of forty-four. Jimmy was born on March 29th, 1966 in Freeport, Texas to Thomas A. Johnson and Sherry L. (Brown) Stockton.
