Janell JoAnn (Lawson) Selzer was born to Thomas L. Lawson and Mary F. (Curtis) Lawson, in Chickasha, Oklahoma, on February 2, 1925. She passed from this life in Lindsay, Oklahoma, on March 1, 2020, at the age of 95.

Janell lived on a farm in Grady County near Bradley, Oklahoma since 1972. She was a member of the United Methodist Church of Alex, Oklahoma. She was a “Rosie the Riveter” who worked at Tinker during WWII installing radios in airplanes. Janell worked more than twenty-five years as a bank teller at the Alex First National Bank.

Of all the interests and enjoyments in her life her family was her greatest treasure. She lived for every moment that she got to spend with them.
