Jearldean "Jerry" (Rogers) Jones of Lindsay, OK went home to be with her Lord April 29, 2012. Jerry was born on a farm North of Lindsay, OK on August 14, 1937 to Charley Winters and Lillie Mae (Turpin) Rogers. She married Terry Gene Jones of Bradley, OK on July 11, 1956.
