Jimmie Mae Cox Padgett of Lindsay, Oklahoma passed away on Monday, October 24, 2011 in Lindsay, Oklahoma, taken suddenly from this life. She was born on November 24, 1935 in Purcell, Oklahoma to James Monroe Cox and Grace (Evans) Cox. She lived most of her young life in the Payne and Wayne areas and later attended and graduated from Purcell High School.

Jimmie married Donald C. Padgett on October 9, 1954 in Norman, Oklahoma. She moved to Southern California soon after and began building her family of four children. In 1970, the family moved from San Bernardino, California to Lindsay, Oklahoma and purchased Holt's Café, renaming it Big "D" Bar-B-Q.
