



## Jimmy Lee Price

January 8, 1932 - December 25, 2015

Jimmy Lee Price was born January 8, 1932 in Hennepin, Oklahoma, to Addie and LZ (Doc) Price. He passed away on Friday, December 25, 2015 at Norman Veterans Center in Norman, Oklahoma at the age of 83. He graduated from Pernel High School in 1950. He joined the U.S. Army and was reassigned to the U.S. Air Force where he served his country in the Korean war. Jim lived in the area all his life, moving to Lindsay in 1982.

As an ordained Baptist minister, Jim pastored congregations in 1st Baptist Church of Ringling, Midway Baptist, Banner Baptist, Hughes Baptist, Hennepin Baptist, retiring from Antioch Baptist in 2012. He was also a missionary with International Crusades for many years, ministering in crusades across Latin and South American countries. Locally he was a member of the American Legion.

Jim loved life, and loved people. He loved to cook and was an accomplished grill master and BBQ Chef. He had many hobbies that included being a ham radio operator, flying small planes, motorcycling, camping and sightseeing in his motorhome. In later years he enjoyed Sunday afternoon rides through local countrysides.
