August 28, 1934 - June 20, 2007

Jo Lurline Long, 72, of Scottsdale, Arizona passed away June 20, 2007. She was born August 28, 1934 to Paul John Fronterhouse and Vera E. Fronterhouse Horton. She graduated from Healdton High School in 1952, from East Central Oklahoma State University in 1975, with a Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing and from Oklahoma University Health Science Center in 1980 with a Master of Science degree in Nursing. Jo worked as a clinical Registered Nurse in various hospitals for many years, taught nursing at East Central Oklahoma State University; Connors State College; and Oklahoma City Community College, and retired in 1994 as a Professor of Nursing. After retirement, she attended Medical Legal Institute in Houston and became a Certified Legal Nurse Consultant. Jo was co-owner and co-founder of Legal Nurse Consultants of Oklahoma, LLC. She married Dr. W. M. "Dub" Long on December 23, 1953 in Healdton, Oklahoma. He passed away October 11, 1978 where they lived for many years and where their children were raised. One of the highlights of her life, besides family and the nursing profession, was a pilgrimage to the Holy Land in June 1993. Jo was preceded in death by her husband; parents, grandparents, an infant grandson, Timothy Gay, older brother, Richard D. Fronterhouse, and a special aunt who was also a childhood friend, Betty Jean Rainey. She is survived by her son, Trey Long, daughter, Tamara Long-Scott, and brothers, Paul, David and Tom Fronterhouse. A memorial service will be held at 10:30 a.m. Friday, June 29, 2007, at United Methodist Church 113 W. Chickasaw St. Lindsay, Oklahoma.
