



## Joseph Caleb Lindsey

January 31, 1922 - April 8, 2015

Joseph Caleb "Joe" Lindsey was born in Empire, Oklahoma on January 31, 1922 to John and Mellie Lindsey. Joe served his country during World War II in the U.S. Army Air Corps serving as a B-24 Bomber Pilot. He served for five years. He returned home and married Allene Campbell On January 18, 1948 at the First Baptist Church in Lindsay, Oklahoma with the ceremony performed by Rev. Glenwood Busby. Joe lived in and around Lindsay, Oklahoma for most of his life. He worked in the oilfield in all capacities for at least forty years. He was a member for over 65 years of the American Legion Ball-Smith Post 23 (serving in all capacities), a member of the VFW and a 32nd degree Mason. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Lindsay where he was baptized, married and his funeral service is being held. Joe loved playing dominoes and cards, assembling jigsaw puzzles, reading and visiting with family and friends. Joe passed from this life on Wednesday evening, April 8, 2015 at Integris Baptist Medical Center in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma at the age of 93.
