Josh was a member of the National Guard Reserve and was currently on active duty and awaiting the time he would leave for Iraq which he was looking forward to. He considered his unit his family.

Josh is survived by his father and stepmother John and Beverly Crites, and his maternal grandmother, Betty Estep.
