



## Kathern O. Williams

June 4, 1921 - June 4, 2002

Kathern O. Williams, age 81, a lifetime resident of Lindsay, OK, passed away on June 4, 2002 in Lindsay. She was born on Feb. 7, 1921 in Lindsay to Sam and Vena Freeman Williams.

Kathern worked at the First National Bank in Lindsay for fifty-three years as a Teller, Cashier and Vice-President. She was member of the United Methodist Church, a member of the Lindsay Band Secretary for forty-nine years, and a lifetime member of the Lindsay Historical Society. She was named Woman of the Year in 1985. Also she recieved the Oklahoma Department of Human Services Volunteer Award. She belonged to the Lindsay Civic Arts, and a bowler for a number of years.

She is survived by one brother, Kenneth Williams; and one sister, Kay Rita Williams, both of Lindsay. She is preceded in death by both parents.

Funeral services will be on Thursday, June 6, 2002 at 2:30 p.m. at the United Methodist Church in Lindsay with Rev. Charles E. Watson officiating. Burial will be in Green Hill Cemetery.
