Kay Rita Williams of Lindsay, Oklahoma entered into her eternal rest on Monday, August 26, 2013 at Norman Regional Hospital in Norman, Oklahoma at the age of 77. She was born on a farm southwest of Lindsay, Oklahoma on January 22, 1936 to Sam Williams and Vena (Freeman) Williams.

Kay Rita was a lifetime resident of Lindsay. She graduated from Lindsay High School and Hill's Business College in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. She started working for the First National Bank in Lindsay in 1955 and worked there fifty-five years as a teller, a cashier and vice-president.
