Kenneth “Ken” George McKee was born on February 7, 1950 in Aberdeen Proving Grounds, Maryland to William Henry McKee and Lena Fae (Fleming) McKee. He entered into eternal rest on April 11, 2018 in Norman, Oklahoma at the age of 68.

Ken was raised in Alex, Oklahoma but has lived the majority of his life in Lindsay, Oklahoma. He was one of six children in the McKee household. He graduated from the Alex High School in 1968. After graduating, Ken enlisted in the United States Army to serve his country. He was a Forward Artillery Observer for the 4th Infantry during the Vietnam War.
