July 7, 1929 - April 11, 2008

Kohen Tabor passed away on the morning of April 11, 2008 at the Sulphur Memorial Hospital from a sudden heart attack. He was born at Stratford, Oklahoma on July 7, 1929, to Ivanhoe and Levy Tabor both who preceded him in death. He married the love of his life, Charlotte Graves on June 25, 1949, in Greensburg, Kansas. Kohen was a sergeant in the Army National Guard, 45th Thunderbird division. He was deployed during the Koren War and he felt it was a high honor that he could serve his country. Kohen and Charlotte moved to Lindsay after he graduated with honors from Southwestern University with a degree in pharmacy. They opened their drug store in 1964 and have successfully operated this business for 44 years. Kohen truly had a great passion and love for his business and most of all his ever loyal customers. He was a member of Central Oklahoma Compounders Association and was awarded the title of Eagle by the Professional Compounder Center of America. In the pharmacy circles he is referred to as the Grandfather of compounding. He was a member of the first Baptist Church in Lindsay.

He is preceded in death by a sister Vadna Willis, and two brothers Algee and Ray Tabor. He is survived by his wife, Charlotte Tabor of Lindsay. He is also survived by three children, Mike Tabor of Coweta, Susan Rogers and Kalyn Tabor both of Lindsay.
